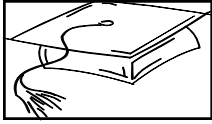

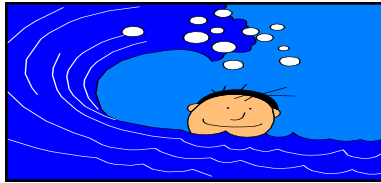

- RECYCLE! Buy minimally packed goods when possible
Wash clothes in cold or warm water, not hot
Install low-flow showerheads and ULF or HE toilets to use less water (rebates available)
Run the dishwasher only when it's full; don't use heat to dry dishes
Replace standard light bulbs with CF bulbs
Plug air leaks in windows and doors
Replace old appliances with energy-efficient models.
Adjust your thermostat - lower in the winter, higher in the summer
